April 13 at 7 pm & April 14 at 1 pm

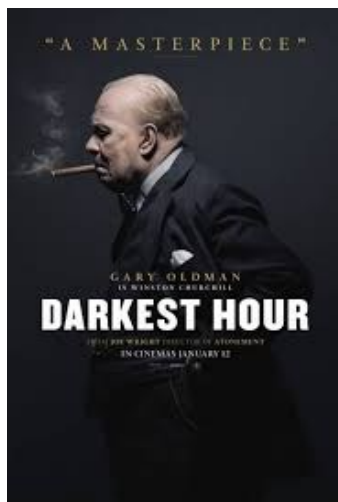
