

2020 General Election Information – Tuesday, November 3, 2020

(Please note that information and deadlines related to the November 3 election are subject to change, so please confirm all information shown below by checking the NYS Board of Elections or Westchester County Board of Elections websites shown at bottom of this page.

- **Registration deadline:** The last day to register to vote for the Nov. 3 General Election is Oct. 9, 2020 in person or by postmark. Additional information and forms to register can be found at <https://www.elections.ny.gov/VotingRegister.html>
- **Change of Address deadline:** Any change of address (within Westchester County) must be received by Oct. 14, 2020.
- **Early Voting will be held on Saturday, Oct. 24, 2020 through Sunday, Nov. 1, 2020.** For early voting locations and times in Westchester go to <https://citizenparticipation.westchestergov.com/voting/early-voting-2020>
- **The Polls will be open on General Election Day, Tuesday, Nov. 3, 2020, from 6 a.m. to 9 p.m.** To find your polling place site locations go to <https://citizenparticipation.westchestergov.com/find-polling-place> (Note: Your polling location may be different than in previous years due to the COVID-19 pandemic.)

Absentee Ballot Information and Deadlines for November 3 General Election:

Pursuant to Governor Cuomo's signed election law from Aug. 20, 2020, **all registered voters may apply for an Absentee Ballot due to risk or fear of illness including COVID-19 as one of the valid reasons by checking the temporary illness or physical disability box on the absentee ballot application.** Voters may apply for an Absentee Ballot online, in person, by e-mail, fax or mail. **You can still vote in person if you request an absentee ballot (your vote will only be counted once).**

- For absentee applications received by e-mail or fax, the deadline is close of business on Oct. 27, 2020.
- Absentee applications received by postal mail with a postmark on or before Oct. 27 must be processed.
- Please be aware that despite the above deadlines the post office has advised that they cannot guarantee timely delivery of ballots applied for less than 15 days before an election.
- After Oct. 27, voters may apply in person (over the counter) through Nov. 2; or by early voting from Oct. 24 to Nov. 1.
- You may file an Absentee Ballot Application at any time before the deadlines, but ballots will be mailed out after September 18, 2020.
- All returned absentee ballots received by postal mail must be postmarked no later than Nov. 3, 2020. (General Election Day)
- All completed absentee ballots can be dropped off at any of these locations:
 - Westchester Board of Elections office located at 25 Quarropas St., White Plains, NY 10601
 - any early voting poll site from Saturday, Oct. 24 through Sunday, Nov. 1
 - any Nov. 3 Election Day poll site

(Please note that when mailing your completed ballot, the USPS recommends that voters allow enough time for ballots to be returned to the Board of Elections, which is generally seven days ahead of the general election. New York State requires your ballot to be both postmarked by November 3, 2020 and received by

our Board by November 10, 2020. Voters who mail in their ballots on Election Day must be aware of the posted collection times on collection boxes and at the Postal Service's retail facilities, and that ballots entered after the last posted collection time will not be postmarked until the following business day.
