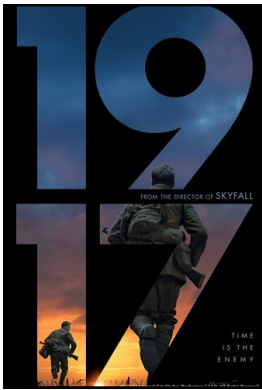


Friday Night & Saturday Afternoon at the Movies

Best Picture nominee and winner of two Oscars for Sound and Film Editing.

On his 85th birthday, crime novelist Harlan Thrombey is found dead in his room with his throat slit. Just as authorities are about to dismiss the tragedy as suicide, Benoit Blanc arrives at the scene to conduct his own investigation. This classic whodunit stars Daniel Craig.
