Indoor Mobile Materials List:

Round plastic container*
Hole punch (unless you hang strings from a stick)
Glue
Card stock paper (or index cards)
Markers
Scissors
String or yarn
Beads*

The base for the string for your mobile:

You can use a plastic flower pot, a plastic round food container, even a big cup. If you do not have something of this shape, you can also just use a stick to hang the strings down from.

Beads note:

You only need the beads if you are using a round plastic container with holes as your base for the string to hang from. This is used so you can string the string through the hole without it falling through the hole. You can use buttons, a small cut crafts stick, or a paperclip instead. You may also want to use beads to string as an additional decoration to your mobile. This is optional.
