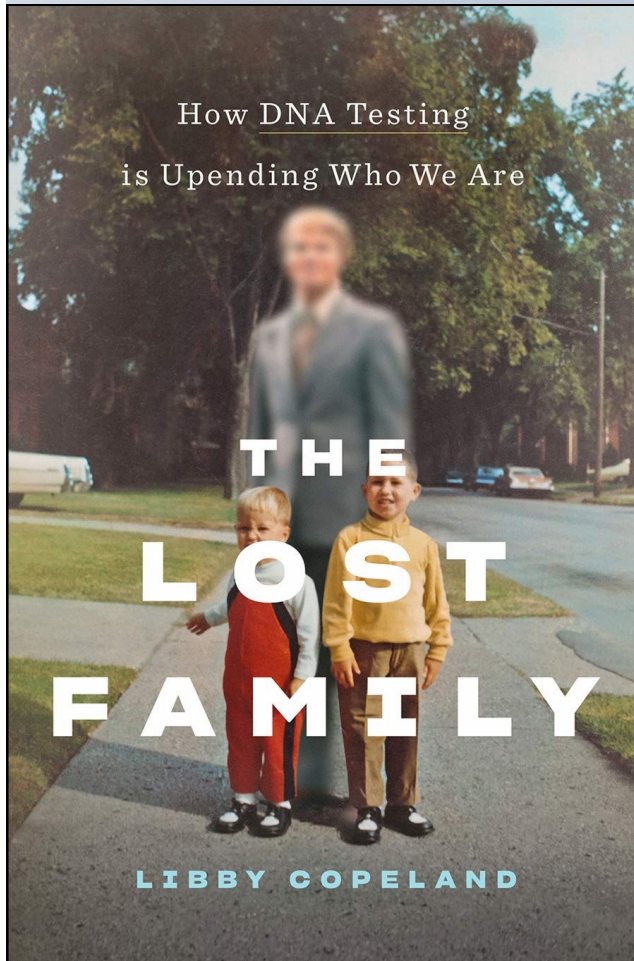


# ***The Lost Family***
