Join us for monthly stimulating discussions of selections from great world literature, beginning Tues., Sept. 9 from 7:30-8:45 p.m. in person at the Briarcliff Manor Public Library (first session at 1 Library Road; subsequent sessions at 555 Pleasantville Rd). Each discussion will be guided by a trained leader who may ask questions but not answer them. Using the 'shared inquiry' method, readers explore their understanding of a thought-provoking work of literature or philosophy in a well-conducted discussion, allowing participants to reach a level of insight not often achieved when reading alone.
